





Undergraduate Research Program

PUCPR offers undergraduate research programs designed to introduce students to the scientific research environment. Through these programs, undergraduate students have the opportunity to learn and apply research methods in all fields of science, as well as to stimulate scientific and creative thinking processes. The program is supported by a scholarship, and opportunities are available for incoming international students interested in engaging in research projects developed at PUCPR.

PIBIC Master

Research opportunity for talented senior international students with an outstanding research profile and interest in pursuing a Master's degree at PUCPR.

Additional opportunities available for international students:

Internships at local companies for exchange students from partner institutions;

Free mover admissions for independent, fee-payer international students interested in attending PUCPR for one or more academic semesters. Scholarship opportunities for international students seeking graduate degree programs.

Mission: Aligned with institutional principles, the Office for Internationalization aims to promote and support the internationalization of the university as a means to achieve excellence in academia by preparing citizens and professionals inserted into the global community.



PUCPR has academic cooperation agreements with over 230 partner universities from more than 30 countries in all continents, which provides the students and the faculty a variety of exchange and study abroad opportunities during their academic programs at the institution, including sponsored exchange programs (funded by the Brazilian government and/or partner institutions) such as Brafitec, Brafagri, Marca, and Erasmus Mundus.
